Mayor Milligan called the meeting to order.

Mayor Milligan said this meeting is to consider the 2008-2009 city budget by approving an ordinance setting the ad valorem tax rate. Mayor Milligan said this is a tax rate increase from last year and stated that the tax increase on a one hundred thousand dollar home would be approximately twenty dollars, which is two percent less than anticipated. Mayor Milligan said before three percent raises were given to city employees he would like the employees to be placed on a rating system and there should be consistency among the city employee's ratings. City Manager Vince DiPiazza said he is not against employee evaluations but the 2008-2009 city budget is effective in two days, October 1, 2008. A motion was made by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Sims, and passed unanimously to approve the First Reading of Ordinance No. 1058 setting the ad valorem tax rate at \$.148944.
