BE IT REMEMBERED THAT THERE CAME AND WAS HELD A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARK BOARD OF THE CITY OF DUMAS, TEXAS IN THE DUMAS COMMISSION CHAMBERS/MUNICIPAL COURT ROOM, 124 EAST 7TH STREET OF SAID CITY:

Don Trayler called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Ricky Casanova, seconded by Mike Barr, and passed unanimously to approve the May 3, 2018 Regular Park Board meeting minutes.

Don Trayler asked if everyone had looked at the pictures of the grills. Mr. Trayler said there are 6 grills for a total of \$3,198. The grills are \$533 each. Mr. Trayler asked if this cost included shipping and Park Superintendent Oscar Garcia said no. Mr. Trayler asked if the grills came with the inground pipe and Mr. Garcia said yes. A motion was made by Jessie Frausto, seconded by Chris Benson, and passed unanimously to approve the purchase of 6 covered grills from Upbeat for a total of \$3,198 plus shipping cost; 3 grills for McDade Park, 2 grills for Morton Park, and 1 grill for Shamrock Park.

A motion was made by Mike Barr, seconded by Ricky Casanova, and passed unanimously to approve the purchase of roofing items from Bartlett's Lumber for \$397.39 to repair the gazebo roof at Morton Park.

The park board looked at chain basketball nets. The nets are \$10.29 each and Mr. Garcia needs 7. Don Trayler asked if extra nets should be purchased. A motion was made by Mike Barr, seconded by Jessie Frausto, and passed unanimously to approve the purchase of 10 chain basketball nets from Epic Sports for a total of \$102.90 plus shipping cost; 2 for McDade Park, 1 for Durrett Park, 1 for Shamrock Park, 1 for N. Birge Park, 1 for S. Birge Park and 1 for Twichell Park.

Don Trayler opened the Work Session.

In other park board business, Mike Barr asked if the mud volleyball pits could be filled with dirt because the standing water is causing mosquitos. Mr. Garcia said the street department treats the water. Debbie Beilue asked if the picnic tables were delivered for the new pavilion at McDade Park. Mr. Garcia said yes and they were put in the pavilion before Dogie Days. Ricky Casanova asked if the slides had been delivered and Mr. Garcia said no.

Mr. Trayler said the next park board meeting is August 9, 2018.
