Moore County Judge Rowdy Rhoades opened the meeting. In attendance were several people from the community including the relief route work group committee. Judge Rhoades discussed the relief routes and presented maps for an East route and a West route. Judge Rhoades told the public that GPS already has traffic turning at Four Way instead of traveling through Dumas. Judge Rhoades said the relief route would not begin for approximately 10 years but the committee prefers the East route. Mayor Sims said the work group has met with and without Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and TxDOT's main focus is to move all traffic faster and safer. Mr. Sims said this meeting is to get the community's input and ideas so the work group can present them to TxDOT. Mayor Sims said the work group wants to do what benefits the citizens the best. People in attendance were able to ask questions.
